Church Governance

St. Luke's Church is governed by a committee called the Vestry, which meets once a month. The Vestry oversees the spiritual and financial life of the Parish. Everyone is welcome to join the choir.

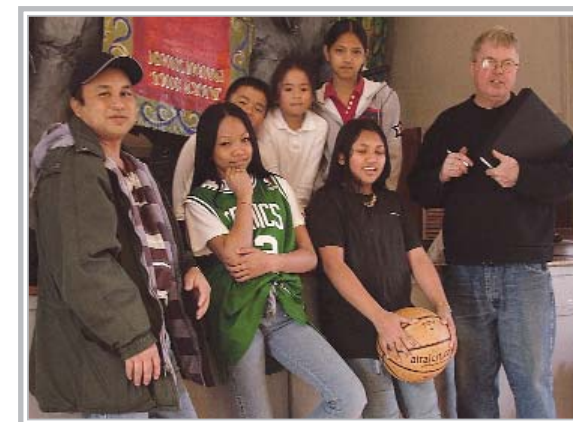


Youth Group
